Crisp, Sr., the facility was named on September 28, 1996, in recognition of his academic and athletic support of UT Martin at the request of his son, Harry Crisp, Jr. Previously the building carried the name Prentice Cooper, Governor of Tennessee, 1939-1945, for appropriating the funds to rebuild the facility in 1941 after the 1930 building burned.
<b>Nick and Cathy Dunagan Alumni Center</b>	Dunagan Alumni Center	10/15/10	Honoring Nick and Cathy Dunagan, alumni and respectively, UT Martin Chancellor Emeritus and former first lady. The Dunagan family generously supported the university for decades. Constructed in 1970 as the Chancellor's Residence and repurposed in 2008 to accommodate the Chancellors' Suite and Alumni Relations offices.
